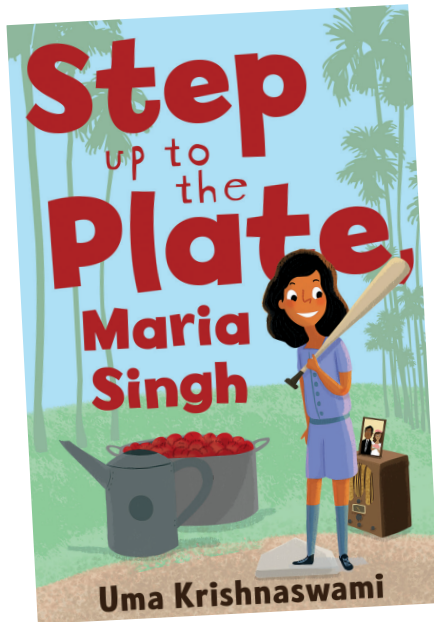
### Roundtable Reading
